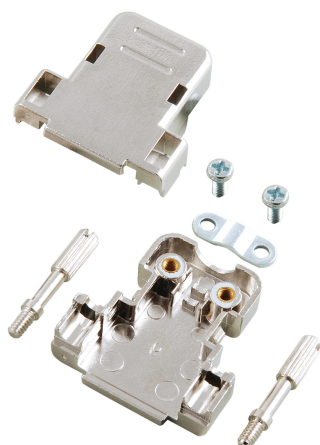

General data

The D-Sub hood E-DH metallized from EFB-Elektronik is designed as a plastic hood for 9-pin connectors. With a 180° cable outlet and straight cable entry, it is suitable for compact and standard-compliant cable connections in a wide range of applications.

- Plastic hood in metallized/silver design
- Suitable for 9-pin D-Sub connectors
- Cable outlet 180° with straight cable entry

The material plastic supports a robust and at the same time practical protection solution for technical applications where a precisely fitting cover for D-Sub interfaces is required. The maximum cable diameter of 6.0 mm takes into account common cables and facilitates integration into existing systems. The temperature range of -25 to 70 °C covers typical operating conditions.
